

I hope you all have a wonderful weekend, and I look forward to seeing you all on Monday



### Safequarding: **Medical Needs** in School

Please can you ensure that all children's medical information is kept up to date. School needs to be aware of medical conditions and regular medication taken. If medication is kept in school, it is the parent/quardian's responsibility to ensure medication is updated and changed before expiry. We will not administer medication that is out of date.

If your child has an allergy they need their own bottle of antihistamine in school. For asthmatic's, reliever inhalers need to be in school with a completed Asthma Plan. Parent/Guardian's will need to complete a medication form at the school office. This will be signed when medication is administered.

If you have any questions regarding how we manage medical needs or need further information regarding medical conditions, please see the school office.

#### **Tips**

- \* Ensure children are registered with a dentist and get a regular check-up.
- \* Ensure children are registered with an optician and get regular check-ups.
- \* Ensure children are registered with a doctor and seek medical advice when needed.
- \* Attend medical/hospital appointments so that children are not discharged from services.
- \* Ensure children get a balanced diet, a range of vitamins and wear appropriate clothing for the weather.
- \* Get outside to develop and strengthen children's natural immune system.
- \* Talk to children about their medical needs so they know how to help keep themselves safe.


#### Christmas Lunches
