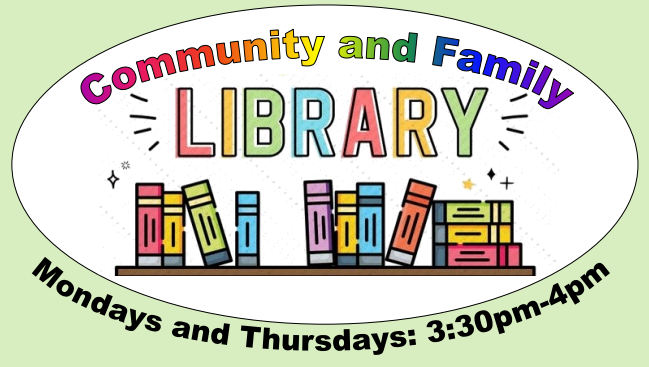

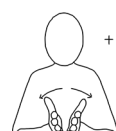
Hands move together in a clockwise circle
