Is it illegal to park on zig-zag lines outside schools?

Yes, it's always illegal to park on yellow zig-zag lines anywhere.

Parking and Drop off Outside School.

When dropping off and picking up children you **should not park** on the yellow zig-zags outside the school gates **AT ANY TIME**, and you should NOT IGNORE the safety cones.

Restrictions are in place to keep this area clear for the safety of everyone at school, especially between 8am - 4pm.

People who park in these areas are putting the safety of not only their own, but other children at risk.
