Safeguarding: Alcohol and drug misuse



Unfortunately, many people are struggling with harmful and hazardous use of drugs or alcohol, and in many cases both.

Alcohol and drug misuse damages too many lives; addiction hurts individuals both physically and mentally. It can also hurt those living with the person struggling with addiction and substance misuse, particularly children.

There is a strong association between drug and alcohol misuse and domestic violence. Children exposed to substance misuse and/or domestic violence, often called Adverse Childhood Experiences, can experience significant trauma.

The council commissions services from Change, Grow, Live to support people who are struggling with harmful and hazardous use of drugs or alcohol or both.



Change Grow Live is a health and social care charity. We provide free and confidential treatment, support and information about drug and alcohol use, smoking, homelessness, justice and probation, and employment. We are here for you, judgement-free, whatever your circumstances.

When you come to one of our services, we'll make sure you feel welcome and supported. We'll always respect and support your choices, and we'll work together to find the right plan for you.
